

GRANT COUNTY CEMETERY DISTRICT
MEETING MINUTES
October 9, 2015

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Darrin Figgins, Board Members Mary Sullivan, Cecil Simpson, Bobbi Higgs, and Ronald Craft

Chairman Darrin Figgins called the meeting to order.

Minutes: The minutes of August 7, 2015 and 3rd quarter financial reports were approved upon motion by Ronald Craft and second by Mary Sullivan.

Sexton Report: Sexton Bernard LaFever reported everything is OK. New valves are in, need to do dirt work. Harry Fry fell in a gravesite and is off for a few days. The board asked for a work release needs to be obtained from the doctor before Harry returns to work.

Irrigation Filter. Chairman Figgins reported that the filter has been disconnected and the city took it to the cemetery for winter storage. Chairman Figgins talked to Rainbird who indicated the water sample was bad but not the worst they've seen and believes the filter should work to alleviate the algae problem.

Filter Building. Cecil Simpson reported that we are waiting for the filter to be delivered to see what size the building needs to be.

Water Well. Gary Knehans sent information that the water rights do not allow the new well to be drilled in the south portion of the cemetery so a diversion has to be obtained. Secretary Shapland is to follow-up with Mr. Knehans and ensure the diversion application being processed.

Information Enclosure: An enclosure (for rules) proposal was reviewed. Following discussion, it was agreed to continue posting rules in the current manner and to publish in newspaper.

Other: Discussion about problems with decorations in cemetery such as benches without foundations. The sexton is to identify any areas of concern and get the information to the secretary so notices can be sent. Ongoing problems should be brought to the Board for review.

There being no further business, Cecil Simpson moved, Ronald Craft seconded, that the meeting be adjourned at 12:25 p.m.
