

The Board of County Commissioners met as a Board of Canvassers at 9:00 a.m. to review the votes cast at the Presidential General Election held November 6, 2012; and to hold a conference call with the County Attorney concerning the Museum roof. All members and the County Clerk were present.


No discrepancies were found in the tallies made by the original canvass. After processing 127 provisional ballots and reviewing write in votes, the final totals did not change the outcome of any race. The totals are recorded in the Abstract of Votes Cast Journal in the County Clerk's Office.

At 10:20 a.m. the commissioners met with Ginger Anthony, Museum Curator and Jeff Trotman, Museum Board Member. The new roof design sent by A-Lert Roofing was reviewed. The design would remove the present roof at the Museum and replace it with a metal roof with outside gutters. It was the consensus of the group the new design would correct the leaking. The group held a conference call with David Black, County Attorney, to give approval of A-Lert's design. Mr. Black agreed with the decision and will contact Neil Berry with A-Lert Roofing.

The commissioners adjourned at 11:30 a.m., to meet again in regular session at 9:00 a.m. on November 20, 2012.
