Don Button held a demonstration on WebEOC. WebEOC stands for "Web-based Emergency Operations Center". It is the original web-enabled crisis information management system developed by ESi and provides secure real-time information sharing to help managers make sound decisions quickly. Its use for events is worldwide and exhaustive. As an incident-based information management system, WebEOC is capable of managing multiple ongoing incidents simultaneously yet separately, or agencies and users can roll-up multiple incidents for viewing in a common master view. In addition to real-time access to information, WebEOC provides an extensive information retrieval and reporting capability. KDEM's WebEOC will house the Spill and All Hazards database, the Form A reporting process. Emergency managers can find spill information for their counties on this site.

Nancy Lucas talked about the hospital employees are now Centura Health Associates as of July 3rd.

Mike Salsbury with Pioneer Electric talked about some of the power outages they have had with the storms that have gone thru. Most of these were not in Grant County.

The Kansas Emergency Management Association (KEMA) conference will be September 13 to 18.

The next regular LEPC meeting will be August 18 at 11:30am at Grant County Courthouse basement training room.

Toni made a motion to adjourn and Mike seconded. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 12:40pm.
